St. Joseph's Hospital Perinatal program move to LHSC

All perinatal program services currently located at St. Joseph's Health Care, London, including the tertiary care obstetrical and neonatal intensive care units, begin moving to Victoria Hospital, LHSC on Saturday, June 4, 2011. Obstetricians at St. Joseph's Hospital will be moving to LHSC with the program.

Please continue with your high-risk referrals to St. Joseph's until June 4. Low risk or moderate risk patients in London should continue to be referred to either LHSC or St. Joseph's Hospital.

After June 4, all patients will need to be referred to LHSC for all levels of perinatal care.

All registered patients will receive patient information brochures with more details about the move and what it will mean for them.

Planned service reductions during LHSC's adult mental health care program move

All adult acute mental health care services at LHSC are moving to new spaces at Victoria Hospital, April 11-29, 2011.

As a result of the move, please note that Coordinated Intake will be closed to referrals on Thursday, April 14 and Friday, April 15, 2011. Reduced service will be offered on Monday, April 18, with full service resuming on Tuesday, April, 19, 2011.
