

Person Protective Equipment (PPE) Requirements



Lab coats are to be worn at all times while working in the laboratory. Lab coats can be worn when moving between labs to conduct work, but should not be worn in the office pods, when traveling through the hospital for lunch or on breaks.



Gloves are to be worn while working in the laboratory with biologicals or chemicals or during other lab procedures. Follow the Glove Safe Work Practice.



The minimum standard footwear in the lab is a shoe with closed toe and heel (No sandals or ballet flats).



Safety glasses, goggles or face shields as required
