Delineation	Privileges	Educational and Experience Requirements
A	All activities and procedures generally performed by physicians certified in the specialty.	Specialty Certification and Fellowship from the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada, or an Academic Certificate of Registration from the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario.
B	<p>All activities and procedures generally performed by physicians certified in the specialty inclusive of Category A Delineation.</p> <p>Procedures requiring the use of specialized equipment and/or training as approved by the Chief of the Department including:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Facial cosmetic surgery 2. Major head and neck surgery, including reconstructive surgery 3. Cochlear implants 4. Robotic Surgery 	Certification and Fellowship as indicated in Category A Delineation, and additional training as defined and supported by the Chief of the Department.
C	Limited activities and procedures generally performed by physicians not certified in the specialty, but who have experience, training and/or demonstrated competence or for the purposes of training/obtaining new skills.	Certificate of Registration from the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario, or Specialty Certification from the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada, or Certification from the College of Family Physicians of Canada.
LASER	Procedures requiring the use of lasers.	Provide proof of certification in accordance with the Canadian Standards Associate (CSA) standard Z386. Initial verification of certification is confirmed by the LHSC Laser Safety Officer followed by bi-annual recertification.
