RECENTLY MOVED:

Victoria Hospital's Women's Ambulatory Care and Medical Genetics

Medical Genetics and Women's Ambulatory Clinics have moved to new spaces within Victoria Hospital.

The following clinics are located in zone B, level 5:

- Medical Genetics
- Maternal Fetal Medicine
- Ultrasound
- Urodynamics
- Obstetric/Gynecology Clinics
- Pregnancy Options Program

There are no changes to the referral process and phone and fax numbers for the program and its clinics remain the same. Registered patients have been notified of this move directly.

Children's Hospital's Paediatric Medical Day Unit (PMDU)

Children's Hospital's PMDU has relocated to brand new space in zone B, level 1. There are no changes to the referral process and phone and fax numbers for this program and its clinics will remain the same. Patients and families have been notified of this move directly.

St. Joseph's Hospital Perinatal program begins move to LHSC June 4, 2011

All perinatal program services currently located at St. Joseph's Health Care, London, including the tertiary care obstetrical and neonatal intensive care units, begin moving to Victoria Hospital, LHSC on Saturday, June 4, 2011. Obstetricians at St. Joseph's Hospital will be moving to LHSC with the program.

Please continue with your referrals to obstetrician/gynecologists as you normally would, noting that after June 4 all levels of perinatal care will be provided at LHSC.

All registered patients have received patient information brochures with more details about the move and what it will mean for them.

LHSC's Birthing Centre

On May 30, 2011, LHSC's Birthing Centre will relocate to its brand new space within Victoria Hospital - zone B, level 4. Phone and fax numbers for the birthing centre will remain the same. Registered patients at LHSC have been notified of this move directly.

LHSC's Mother Baby Care Unit

On June 3, LHSC's Mother Baby Care Unit will move within Victoria Hospital to newly refurbished space in zones C and D, level 4. This move does not have any external implications.

LHSC's Inpatient Gynecology Unit

On June 8, the Inpatient Gynecology Unit at LHSC will move within Victoria Hospital to newly refurbished space in zone D, level 4. This move does not have any external implications.

Women's Ambulatory Health Services St. Joseph's Health Care, London	Zone B, level 5 – Victoria Hospital Women's health services at St. Joseph's Hospital are moving to zone B, level 5 at Victoria Hospital May 31-June 3, 2011. Services include, maternal fetal medicine, mother baby wellness, pre-admission, ultrasound, urodynamics and the obstetric/gynecology clinics. Registered patients have been notified of this move directly.
Developmental Follow up Clinic (DFC) St. Joseph's Health Care, London	Zone B, level 1 - Children's Hospital On June 6, 2011 the Developmental Follow-Up Clinic currently located at St. Joseph's Hospital will be moving to zone B, level 1 at Children's Hospital. It will consolidate with the services of LHSC's PMDU. There will be no changes to the referral process. Patients and families have been notified of this move directly.
Inpatient Gynecology St. Joseph's Health Care, London	Zone D, level 4 - Victoria Hospital On June 10, 2011, Inpatient Gynecology beds located at St. Joseph's Hospital will be moving to zone D, level 4 at Victoria Hospital. The beds will consolidate with LHSC's current inpatient gynecology unit. This move does not have any external implications.
Endoscopy/Medical Day Unit/IV Therapy London Health Sciences Centre	Zone B, level 2 - Victoria Hospital Victoria Hospital's Endoscopy, Medical Day and IV Therapy units will be moving to new space in zone B, level 2 on June 13, 2011. There will be no changes to the referral process. Patients will be notified of this move directly.
Colposcopy and Gynecology Clinics St. Joseph's Health Care, London	Zone B, level 4 - St. Joseph's Hospital The Colposcopy and Gynecology Clinics at St. Joseph's Hospital will be relocating to new space in zone B, level 4 on June 13, 2011. There will be no changes to the referral process and registered patients have been notified of this move directly.
Colposcopy Clinic London Health Sciences Centre	Zone B, level 4 - St. Joseph's Hospital The Colposcopy Clinic at Victoria Hospital will be moving to zone B, level 4 at St. Joseph's Hospital on June 15-16, 2011. Please continue with referrals as you normally would, noting that as of June 15 all patients will receive care at St. Joseph's Hospital. Registered patients have been notified of this move directly.
Urgent Neurology Clinic London Health Sciences Centre	Zone B, level 2 - Victoria Hospital The Urgent Neurology Clinic currently located at South Street Hospital will be moving to zone B, level 2 at Victoria Hospital on June 17, 2011. Phone and fax numbers for the program will remain the same and there will be no changes to the referral process.
